

### Viburnum plicatum 'Mariesii'

#### Japanese snowball



In spring time you can catch a glimpse of the tree in full splender, as at this time, white flowers appear and leaves turn a gorgeous shade of green. Meanwhile, in autumn you will see a dramatic transition of colour, paired with red and black fruits.

As this tree is deciduous, during colder months the branches stand bare. This is a great time to see the shrubs incredible form, as they grow in a wide spreading tier structure.

It is happy to be placed in pots or garden borders, making it the perfect feature for any patio or smaller garden. Easy to maintain, *Viburnum plicatum 'Mariesii'* can withstand hard regenerative pruning. However, if you are looking for a more architectural, statement piece, leave the specimen to grow to its natural state and it will become an incredible addition to any garden.
